- 2. Kathleen McAuliffe recites If I Were a Lady, a poem by Percy French (1854-1920)
- 3. Desmond Ellis reads from his creative non-fiction memoir of his Dublin boyhood, *Bockety* (published by Brandon Books, Ireland, 2006)
- 4. Johanne Patry sings Comin' Thru the Rye accompanying herself on the guitar
- 5. Brian Dooley reads from *A Blue Boy in a Black Dress* by T. F. Rigelhof (published by Oberon Press, 1995)
- 6. Patrick Hutchinson plays and sings Roving Journeyman, also known as Red Haired Boy
- 7. Geraldina Mendez discusses the influence of Wagner on James Joyce, then plays and sings one of Joyce's favourite passages from *Tristan und Isolde, Brangäne's Warning*
- 8. Larissa Andrusyshyn reads two of her latest poems
- 9. Anne Lewis reads a recently published short story
- 10. Kathleen McAuliffe sings Bid Adieu, words and music by James Joyce
- 11. Brian Dooley reads another passage from T. F. Rigelhof's A Blue Boy in a Black Dress, featuring Toronto as "the new Jerusalem"
- 12. Johanne Patry sings *The Holy City* (music by Michael Maybrick, under the alias Stephen Adams, and lyrics by Frederic Weatherly). Prerecorded piano accompaniment by Geraldina Mendez.
- 13. Patrick Hutchinson plays and sings from Finnegan's Wake (1864)
